Mr. Pincus has argued 25 cases before the Supreme Court, and was Counsel of Record to the Petitioner in *Spokeo v. Robins*, a case to be discussed in this Web Seminar. He formerly served as Assistant to the Solicitor General of the United States and as General Counsel to the Department of Commerce. Mr. Pincus co-founded and serves as co-director of the Yale Law School's Supreme Court Advocacy Clinic.

[Meir Feder](#) is a Partner in the New York, NY office of the Jones Day. He heads that office's Issues & Appeals Practice. Prior to joining the firm, Mr. Feder was a prosecutor in the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York. He argued successfully on behalf of Petitioner Goodyear Dunlop Tires in the 2011 Supreme Court case *Goodyear Dunlop Tires Operations v. Brown*, the ruling in which has proven outcome-determinative in many lower federal court lawsuits. Mr. Feder authored an *amicus curiae* brief on behalf of Experian Information Solutions, Inc. in support of the Petitioner in *Spokeo v. Robins*.
