Jeffrey P. Cunard is the Managing Partner of the Washington, DC office of Debevoise & Plimpton LLP, for which he leads the corporate intellectual property, information technology and e-commerce practices. Mr. Cunard is the author of, and contributes to, books and articles on communications and intellectual property law, and he speaks widely on both subjects. He co-authors the treatise, *Copyright Law: A Practitioner's Guide* (2d ed. 2015), published by Practising Law Institute. For several years, Mr. Cunard taught a seminar at Harvard Law School, "Practical Lawyering: Internet-Related Issues," and served as co-director of the Clinical Program at the Berkman Center for Internet & Society at Harvard University.
